Our February Speaker: Floor Kaspers

Topic: "Beads from Germany: How Does a Town Become a 'Bead Town'?"



Floor Kaspers is a Dutch artist, and she has been exploring European bead history through her travels. Going to factories, old dump sites, shops, and museums, she collects not just beads, but the stories connected to beads. Floor Kaspers has written three books about her discoveries: *Beads from Briare*, *Beads from Tucson*, and *Beads from Jablonec*. Currently, she is working on her latest book, entitled *Beads from Germany*.

For her presentation, Floor will be sharing the fascinating story of German beads. During the last few years, she visited three "bead towns": Lauscha, Neugablonz, and Idar-Oberstein. All of these towns have a prominent place in German bead history. Lauscha is known for its hollow and marble beads, Neugablonz is where many Bohemian bead makers settled after WWII, and Idar-Oberstein is the birthplace of many stone beads. Floor will explore the history of bead making in these towns, and will explain how a "normal" town becomes a "bead town." The lecture will be a mix of history, personal stories, and lots of "show and tell" of German beads.

As part of her work, Floor also collects bead sample cards, and has documented them as part of the [Bead Museum](#) project.



from 10:30 A.M. to 12:00 noon!**

One of San Diego's best-kept treasures is the fabulous museum located on the GIA campus in Carlsbad. This hidden gem houses stunning pieces, including the Chinese Ivory Sculpture, Victoria's Secret Fantasy Collection, the Bahia Sculpture, and much more. The Museum is also currently running its "Variations on a Theme: 25 Years of Design" from the AJDC exhibit.

On April 8, from 10:30 A.M. to 12:00 noon, we have arranged for a free, docent-led tour of the GIA Museum. We will learn a little bit about what the GIA does and see beautiful mineral specimens, jewelry pieces, and gemstone carvings.

Transportation will be on your own, and we will meet at the GIA campus in Carlsbad. For entry to the campus, all visitors (even if you are not driving) must be able to present a photo ID at the gates.

Beautiful and useful! Adorn your favorite stitching area with this lovely design. Use brick stitch and embroidery to create this beautiful flower pin cushion. The pin cushion is approximately 4" with a center bead to accommodate your pins and needles. It can also be adapted and made smaller to be used as a brooch. Students will learn beading techniques in brick stitch and bead embroidery and additional embellishment opportunities. Beading hints, wool felting and finishing methods will also be covered. The kit includes pattern, instructions, charted design, 5 colors of seed beads, beading thread, completed wool center, backing and color picture. Ghost students are permitted.
