David V. Horste of DVHdesigns is a lapidary artist who makes designer focal beads and cabochons. He works in semiprecious stone and organic gems (jet, fossil ivory, etc.), along with upcycled materials such as feldite and patterned glass. His work is done with diamond saws, grinding wheels, drills, sanding belts, and polishing wheels. He sells his work internationally. David has been cutting stones since 1976, beginning at age 10, and has been a full time stonecutter since 1992. So many years of experience working in and researching such a wide variety of materials has given him an incredible body of knowledge on many stone and jewelry related topics. His studio is filled with rocks and gems from all over the world, ranging from familiar materials like turquoise and lapis lazuli to exotic things such as petrified dinosaur bone and fossil mammoth ivory. When he wants to spice things up with some bright color he might cut up a some old chipped Fiestaware or a traffic light lens. Lapidary is a unique art in North America and it's a very time consuming craft which requires tremendous patience and practice.

David will not be teaching a class but this is a speaker you

Capture a stunning German engraved glass cabochon in embellished Peyote and add sparkling fringe to finish off a simple but beautiful pendant that will hang gracefully from a TierraCast branch.

Comprised of Peyote and Fringing techniques that will teach you how to incorporate various sizes of seed beads that can then be embellished in a myriad of ways

Create this unique and beautiful necklace using sparkling Swarovski stones and a variety of Japanese Seedbeads and Czech glass beads by creating a uniquely embellished Right Angle Weave and Netted bezel as well as three smaller Swarovski stones captured in a similar technique. A versatile bail will then suspend your pendant from a gorgeous tubular netted neck strap.  
**Students will Learn:** Modified RAW and netting techniques that will teach you how to incorporate various sizes of seed beads along with a little adjustment in tension to create a unique bezel that can be used on many different focals.  
**Prerequisites:** Working knowledge of Right Angle Weave.
