Mayan Goddess

Capture a stunning German engraved glass cabochon in embellished Peyote and add sparkling fringe to finish off a simple but beautiful pendant that will hang gracefully from a TierraCast branch.

Students will learn:

Comprised of Peyote and Fringing techniques that will teach you how to incorporate various sizes of seed beads that can then be embellished in a myriad of ways

Prerequisites: Basic beginner beadweaving skills helpful. Project may be completed in class.

Create this unique and beautiful necklace using sparkling Swarovski stones and a variety of Japanese Seedbeads and Czech glass beads by creating a uniquely embellished Right Angle Weave and Netted bezel as well as three smaller Swarovski stones captured in a similar technique. A versatile bail will then suspend your pendant from a gorgeous tubular netted neck strap.
Students will Learn: Modified RAW and netting techniques that will teach you how to incorporate various sizes of seed beads along with a little adjustment in tension to create a unique bezel that can be used on many different focals.
Prerequisites: Working knowledge of Right Angle Weave.

Chrysanthemum

Stitch a Stunning Necklace Inspired
by Ornamental Scrollwork!



In this piece, an intricate floral focal features a sparkly crystal surrounded by several layers of lacy seed bead netting. Floral elements repeat throughout the necklace, and are connected with self-supporting scroll elements stitched with cubic right-angle weave (CRAW). An integrated custom clasp completes this beautiful necklace. This class is appropriate for students who already know CRAW and peyote stitch and who are ready to take these techniques to the next level.

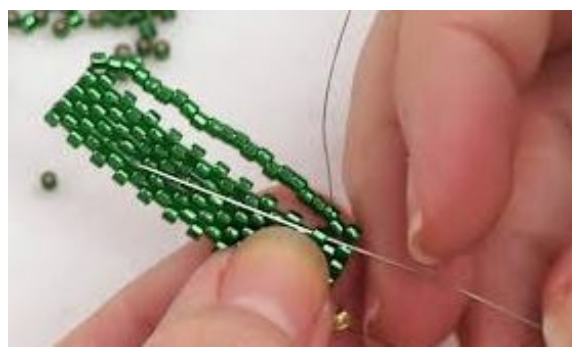
