SDBS (501(c)3) has added to its proud history of community involvement, the Bead-A-Good-Neighbor Program, an outreach effort to help others in our community through the joy of beading. We provide enjoyable beading experiences for kids at Rady's Children's Hospital where our volunteers assist in the creation of lovely pieces of jewelry while the kiddos receive treatment. All materials are provided free of cost.

### Our history of community involvement also includes:

- Beading Clinics at the Naval Hospital in San Diego through the wellness program for physically and emotionally wounded veterans and dependents
- Donating for 20 years to the Mingei Museum and helping it open the permanent Bead Gallery
- Donating to Beads of Courage for their San Diego program for children with cancer
- Providing supplies to Angel Faces, an organization that works with girls with facial disfigurements
- Funding Saraguro Beaders from Ecuador to help them attend the International Folk Art Market in Santa Fe to sell their beadwork
